

Susanville Southeast Gateway Project

Lead Agency: City of Susanville

Project Description

The City of Susanville is actively working on the Southeast Susanville Gateway project, which aims to enhance the area by widening the existing road shoulders, installing new ADA-compliant curb, gutter, and sidewalks, and replacing standard 'cobra head' streetlights with decorative safety lighting

where possible. The project also includes the construction of a pedestrian safety rail on the existing bridge over the drainage ditch and the addition of landscaping features, such as benches, trash receptacles, and bicycle racks. If funding permits, a gateway monument sign will also be added. Ongoing coordination between the Southeast Susanville Gateway project and complete streets projects will ensure the development of a cohesive and uniform main street corridor. The Gateway District begins at the southern end of town on Riverside Drive and extends to Fair Grounds Road. This area is home to newer commercial shopping centers, restaurants, and hotels.
