County Rehab F - Johnstonville Road/Center Road

Lead Agency: County of Lassen

Project Description

Johnstonville Road (from the County line to Center Road) and Center Road are crucial major collectors, serving as key connectors between U.S. 395 to State Route 36. These roads are essential lifelines, heavily used by truckers, emergency vehicles, and school buses. To improve road safety, extend the lifespan of these critical routes, and ensure smoother travel, a comprehensive rehabilitation project is planned. This project will focus on a 2.6-mile



stretch of Johnstonville Road (A27), from the County line to U.S. 395, and a 0.6-mile section of Center Road (CR 215), extending from the Johnstonville Road/Center Road intersection to 0.6 miles northeast. The rehabilitation process will involve pulverizing the existing asphalt concrete (A/C) surface, reshaping and compacting it as a solid base, and completing a 3-inch A/C overlay with aggregate base shoulders. These improvements will enhance the road's durability, safety, and overall rideability, ensuring it remains a reliable and resilient route for years to come.
